- Give your chain of command a chance to solve the problem.
- We are here to assist when everything else seems to not be working.
- Be very open in providing all information -- don't hold back. We'll eventually find out everything, anyway.
- IGs are not Commanders or policy makers. We determine if regulations and policies are followed and that all are treated fairly.
- Keep in mind that IGs can only make recommendations; we do not order resolution, bring punishment or judgment.
- Remember IGs can only resolve a case on the basis of fact.
- Don't expect instant action on your request...Be patient. We have a large workload and finding the truth sometimes takes time.
- Be prepared...Sometimes the answer we give may not be the answer you want to hear.
